Chozha Central Library

Central University of Tamil Nadu Thiruvarur - 610 005 Tamil Nadu.

About the University

Thiruvarur, the ancient capital of the Chozha dynasty, holds a fascinating history of art, music, and dance, making it a cultural gem. This town has been a cradle for traditional dance and music forms. Nestled between two picturesque campuses, River Vettaaru gracefully flows, further enhancing CUTN's serene atmosphere. Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN), established by an Act of Parliament and spread in 520 acres of land on the bank of river Vettaaru and in the surrounding of the lush greens of Cauvery delta region, came into existence in 2009. Our institution takes immense pride in its 13 Schools, with 28 dynamic Departments that foster a diverse and enriching learning environment. Our commitment to comprehensive education is evident in the vast array of 64 academic programmes we offer, tailored to cater to different interests and aspirations. Among these are 29 research programmes, 22 specialized programmes, 6 integrated programmes, 2 undergraduate programmes, and several PG diploma Courses.

Chozha Central Library

The Library was established in the year 2009 and it serves the students, faculty members and staff of the university. The library has a collection of about 49,000 books and 4085 e-books. Of these, more than 5,000 books are reference books (Handbooks, Dictionaries, Encyclopaedias, and colored atlases, etc.) and the rest are Textbooks and General books. Besides these, the library also has CDs/DVDs and subscribes to 109 print journals. The library has been actively interacting with teaching departments and faculty and a pro-active approach to building an essential collection of resources for new programmes being introduced by the various departments have been adopted. It facilitates the access to more than 10,000 online electronic journals through UGC - e-ShodhSindhu, J-Gate, and others. The EPWRF India Time Series database also subscribed for the benefit of faculty, researchers and students in social sciences. The library is fully automated having an online catalogue that can be easily accessed by the users. The library implemented Koha - an open source software package which is an integrated library management system that supports all housekeeping operations of the library. Recently RFID and CCTV security systems are implemented. There is a separate digital librarycentre having 30 computers running on high speed internet. Drillbit & iThenticate anti-plagiarism software access are added by Central Library to check the theses and other publications for the benefit of faculty and students.

About the RRRLF

RRRLF is a central autonomous organization established and fully financed by the Ministry of Culture, Government of India. RRRLF is registered under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961. It is the nodal agency of the Government of India to support public library services and systems and promote public library movement in the country commensurate with the objectives as embodied in its Memorandum of Association. The supreme policy-making body of RRRLF is called the Foundation. It consists of 22 members nominated by the Government of India from amongst eminent educationists, librarians, administrators and senior officials. The Minister of the Department of Culture, Government of India or his nominee is the Chairman of RRRLF.

The complete paper should reach us latest by 20th January, 2024 in Microsoft Word Format only. All the authors, in the case of co authored papers, must pre register for the Conference, and at least one author has to present the paper.
